PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Please take the time to read these few lines.

Pesach is fast approaching. It is a good time to give a report to all the Jewish families of the region.

1. The synagogue on Steadman Street was built in 1926. It is great to have a building for our community needs, but work must be done to maintain it.

I want all of you to realize that extensive work has been done lately. For example:

- In December, a new roof was installed (over 30000\$).
- Camera and interphone have been installed to improve the security (4000\$).
- The two towers and the chimney need extensive repairs (20000\$).

- The stain glass windows that were installed 30 years ago also need to be repaired. In fact, the one in front, by the left side, had a big gap where air could come in. After examination, it was found that the window had not been installed properly. Plywood was used, instead of real material. Moreover, one of the glasses is cracked and was ready to fall. Luckily Tim Davis (with the help of his wife Janet) is very skilled to do the repair. He has taken last week off and has already spend 7 full days working on that project. Thank you so much!!

Obviously, these repairs have a cost. We have applied for help and have received some from both the City of Moncton and the federal government. We will need more.

2. It is important to understand that the composition of the Jewish population has changed considerably in the last few years.

In the past all Jewish families were members of the synagogue, they used the synagogue for prayers, barmitzvah, weddings, funerals, social gatherings at various times of the year

Now it is different: some families are affiliated with the synagogue, but many are not.

But still all families do want to get together to celebrate Jewish events like Purim, Hanukkah, Bar-Mitzvah or Bat-Mitzvah ... It is just that some seem to have a reluctance to formally become members of the synagogue.

Maybe the solution for these families would be to have some kind of cultural association offering Jewish activities, like cooking or language classes, ping pong or chess tournaments, bringing the kids together and introducing them to Jewish culture?

Some families in Moncton want to do Jewish things but do not want to go to an orthodox minyan. We are asking all to go beyond any reluctance they could have– please accept to be part of the group simply because it is good that all Jews stand together and feel that they belong to the same community. There can be two ways to "be part of the group", one will be to be full members of the synagogue, something that would include things like being buried in our cemetery, the others will be to be members of the "Jewish Cultural Group", a group that will be able to use the building of the synagogue for all kind of events: Hebrew classes, sports events, culinary classes etc.

We would very much like to have your feedback on these thoughts. Please take a few minutes to write back and give us your reaction. Thank you.

3. I am preparing the schedule for Pesach. The full Holidays are April 23, 24, 29 and 30. This year, Rabbi Yagod will not be here. Therefore, I must look for someone to read the Torah for these 4 days. I will only look for the days where 10 men have told me they will be coming. That is why I am asking you to tell me which of these 4 mornings you will be in the synagogue. Please simply send me an email, before Friday noon, showing which of April 23, 24, 29 and 30 you will be in Shul. Thank you.

I/We, the undersigned below hereby appoint Rabbi Yitzchok I Yagod to act as my/our agent to sell my/our chametz and any admixture of chametz and any derivative thereof, and food forbidden by the laws of chametz on Pesach and any particles of chametz and flavors of chametz even those that are found in cooking utensils, all of these:

I/we appoint and give full authority to Rabbi Yitzchok I Yagod to sell to any non-Jew he chooses or to any agent he designates even up to 100 agents and does whatever is needed sell the aforementioned chametz in accordance with Halachah.

BY filling in my name below: Rabbi Yitzchok I Yagod is appointed as my/our agent to have full legal and halachic authority and discretion to act and ensure that the sale of this chametz is to be done with all the halachic requirements to ensure that the sale is valid under the laws of the Torah and as well valid under the relevant local laws of the government of the domiciles of the undersigned and of the location of the chametz.

The chametz will be sold on Erev Pesach 5783 and will fully belong to the non-Jew over the entire period of Pesach and including the day before Pesach until **3.5** hours after Pesach ends, whereupon the non-Jewish owner of the chametz can decide to terminate the sale and forfeit the deposit paid thus practically returning the Chametz to where it came from.
