**Betty Hans, z"l**, passed away on August 13. She was 96, Alan, her husband is also 96, on September 14 2023, they would have celebrated their 73rd anniversary. Rabbi Steven Garten, Lisa's

husband, delivered a beautiful eulogy.

We reproduce here some aspects of this eulogy and you will see how a remarkable lady, Betty was.

Betty had an old address book. Found in the address book were the names and information of hundreds of people and of course Bettys collected information about each of them. If Betty met you for more than a few minutes she would strip you of every useful piece of information, record it in the book or in the memory bank of her brain. With this stored information she had the capacity to make each individual feel that they were memorable.

Or if it were someone with an elderly parent, she would ask all the pertinent information to make the individual reveal the family secrets. In movies and Television politicians are often portrayed as having an aid de camp who reminds the politician of the information necessary to properly greet a constituent. She would have been great for that role. I often marveled at how all who were gently and skillfully stripped of information were oblivious to Betty's wiles. To the other she was simply a caring interesting person who could make you feel as you were so important.

Another called her a woman of valour. I can't speak to whether this was a lifelong skill or on acquired later in life but it was a finely-honed skill that Canadian

intelligence services failed to tap into.

Of course, she was so much more than a self-trained active listener. She was a lover of art. A few years ago, at 89, she decided that the house on McAuley Drive needs new pictures on the walls. She visited multiple galleries until she found the pictures she wanted and then negotiated with the owner as if she were in a Middle Eastern shuk. Somehow out of that negotiation Lisa and I became the proud recipient of new original piece of Art. She listened to Opera at the Met religiously. She actively participated in The Moncton gardening circles, the life of this synagogue and in what would have been spare time for others she was a loving sister, mother, grandmother, great grandmother and spouse.
